We praise the Lord for all the good that happens here. Because of the Lord's amazing grace many lives have been changed. Again, thank you for caring.

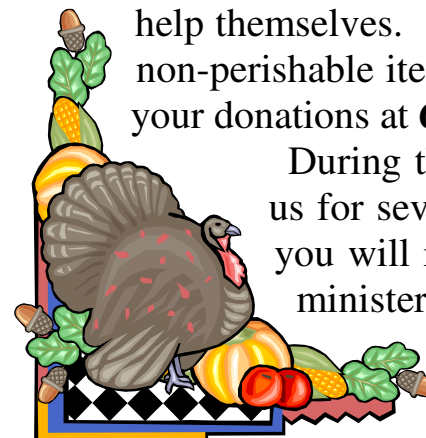
At this time, our ministry is full. The Men's Program Division is packed. Our Women's & Children's Shelter is at capacity. We also had a graduation service for several men and women.
