Thank you for your continuous support. Once again, we have experienced an overload in the services we provide. A special thanks to each of you that has given extra funds and donated many items to help this ministry.

The Men's Program Division is full, and our Women's and Children's Shelter is also full. We have had an average of 14 women and 3 children for many months.

We also have been blessed with many boxes of canned food collected by postal workers. This came at a time of great need. We feed more on site meals than anyone else in southwest Georgia. We are feeding close to 7,000 meals a month. All this is done without any government grants. Because you care, we are able to help all these people in need.
