Dear Supporters and Friends,

Thank you for your care and compassion for those who desperately need the services this ministry provides. **Without the Lord leading you to help us, we would not be able to provide for those needs.**

We are running full at both the Men's Program Division and the Women's & Children's Shelter – 45 at the Men's Mission and 21 women and children at the Women's Shelter.

The next 3 months will be critical for the Mission. This month we will begin our canned food drive. We need to collect enough non-perishable food to pack over 500 food bags and to serve more meals than usual through the holidays (we have been serving more than 7,500 meals a month).
