Thank you so much for your support & prayers, of which we need more than ever at this time of year.

Please look inside the newsletter for more details about our canned food needs and for MORE Mission updates.

We have the largest feeding program in southwest Georgia. In addition to our men, women, and children we feed, we also feed the public 2 meals a day, 365 days a year. This works out to an average of 7,000 plus meals a month. We also provide food bags to families in need. We need your help. Maybe your church or business or you may be able to have a non-perishable food drive for the Mission. You can call our office at **435-7615** for a pickup, or you can deliver your donation at our office at **604 N. Monroe St.**

We will be having a graduation on June 1st for several of our residents who have finished our New Beginnings program. An average of 65 men, women, and children live at our 3 locations (the men's dorm, the men's graduate dorm, and the women's & children's shelter).

As we enter the hot months, when donations fall and utilities rise, please keep us in your prayers as we minister the love our Lord has for all those who come to us for help.

A special thanks to all of you who give and pray for the Mission.

Canned food drive: If you'd like to help meet our need for canned goods, here are a couple of special requests . . .



Our meals: Our cooks would be glad to receive some large (#10) cans of food (vegetables, fruits, beans, etc.) to serve at our daily meals.

Emergency food bags: Can you donate all or part of a food bag for us to give to a needy family? Here's a list of things we like to include . . .

Let's Feed a Family of Four

- 4 cans of vegetables
- 4 cans of fruit
- 4 cans of meat (tuna, beans, chili, etc.)
- 4 cans of soup
- 1 package of dry beans
- 1 package of cereal or grits
- 1 box of crackers
- 1 package of pasta, rice, etc.
- 1 jar of peanut butter
- 1 jar of jelly or jam
- 1 bar of soap

Thrift Store Warehouse: As many of you may know it has been 17 months since we lost our warehouse at the mission. We were ready for this building to go up in January. However, due to a delay in getting the materials needed and a nearly \$10,000 dollar increase in the cost of the materials we have had a major delay. We had a set budget for this project and now that there has been a \$10,000 dollar increase we could use your help to raise the extra funds. Please pray with us, the Lord has always helped us to meet these needs. We thank the Lord for all of you that support this ministry, and let me add Happy Father's Day to all you dads.
