Let me take the time to thank all of you! Because of your care and compassion, you have helped the mission to recover some of our lost income. However, it looks as though it is going to take several months to recover.

Please look inside the newsletter for more details about our canned food needs and for MORE Mission updates.

I believe the Lord continues to protect us here at the mission. Statistically speaking, we should have been at the top of the list to get COVID-19 cases. When you take into consideration the public that comes to eat at the mission every day. We thank The Lord that we have not currently got any cases here at the mission. We continue to feed to public and our residents around 7,000 meals per month with your help. We recently held a graduation for several of our residents who finished our new beginnings program. We house over 60 men, women, and children at our 3 locations (Men's Program Dorm, Graduate Dorm, and Women & Children's Shelter. Remember we give God's only plan of salvation to everyone who comes to the mission. Only Jesus saves! This is not a religion; it is a relationship with The Lord.

As we enter the hot months, when donations fall and our utilities rise, please keep us in your prayers as we minister The Lord's love to all those who come to us for help. 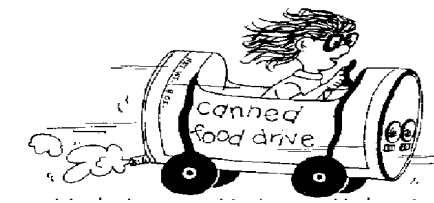
In Memory of Mrs. Mabel Berry

Canned food drive: If you’d like to help meet our need for canned goods, here are a couple of special requests . . .



Our meals: Our cooks would be glad to receive some large (#10) cans of food (vegetables, fruits, beans, etc.) to serve at our daily meals.

Emergency food bags: Can you donate all or part of a food bag for us to give to a needy family? Here’s a list of things we like to include . . .

Let’s Feed a Family of Four

4 cans of vegetables
4 cans of fruit
4 cans of meat (tuna, beans, chili, etc.)
4 cans of soup
1 package of dry beans
1 package of cereal or grits
1 box of crackers
1 package of pasta, rice, etc.
1 jar of peanut butter
1 jar of jelly or jam
1 bar of soap

New Thrift Store Warehouse: If you have not visited or seen our new warehouse, we invite you to come on down and check it out. It’s also the time of year we need to restock our non-perishable food items. We serve over 7,000 meals a month to our residents and the public and provide an average of 75 food bags to families in need per month. We hope and pray you can help out in this area. Thank you!
