~ Giving thanks for God's faithfulness during 32 years of ministry ~*

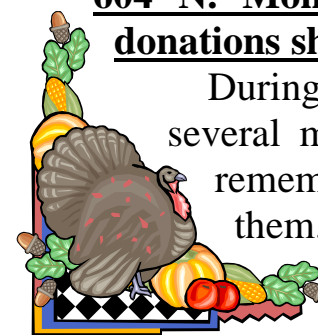
Dear Supporters & Friends,
