We thank you so much for your continuing support of the Mission. As this hot summer starts to wind down, we want to bring you up to date. We News still have not had one COVID case. Between all our locations, and all the public we serve we should have been a hotspot. We think The Lord has protected us, so that we could stay open. We have a new Women's Director at the Women's and Children's ministry and her name is Lynn Livingston. We also have a new Thrift Store manager. We would like for you to come by and meet Ms. Shelly, and while your there browse through our selection of several new items. (The most important service we provide is often overlooked. We show each and every one who comes to us how much God loves them. As we share God's plan of salvation, we let them know how trusting in The Lord can change their lives.)



At the present time, the Mission is near capacity. This is our most difficult time of the year. Our funds are very low, and our need is great now! We run 4 vehicles full-time; fuel is averaging over \$350.00 per week. Last month's utilities for our 14 locations totaled \$5,645.00 due to higher rates. And, we are still feeding over 7,000 meals per month. Also, our non-perishable food items are low.

Many of you have given extra to help with our needs, and we thank you for your help. The Lord has blessed us through these many years. He has always supplied our needs through many caring people. 1 jar of jelly or jam


1 bar of soap
