Other roofs in need of repairs is our kitchen where we feed roughly 7,000 meals a month, our office , the little building at our thrift store as well as our S.S.I. residents house. All of which we believe were effected by the 2017 storm and have been further exacerbated by the subsequent storms since then. Along with the roofs we are in need of floor repairs in the kitchen , and due to the constant rotation of clients here our dorm is still in need of interior repairs. Without the help of donors like you this task is out of our reach, to ensure another 40 years of service to our community (if the Lord is willing) we humbly ask for your help in meeting these needs. On behalf of our residents and those we serve I thank you.
