Along with the roofs we are in need of floor repairs in the kitchen, and due to the constant rotation of clients here our dorm is still in need of interior repairs. Without the help of donors like you this task is out of our reach, to ensure another 40 years of service to our community (if the Lord is willing) we humbly ask for your help in meeting these needs.
