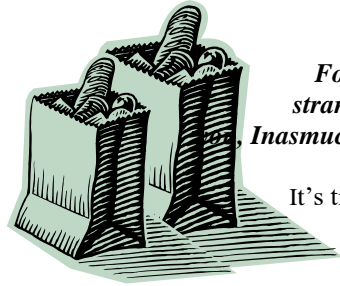

1 package of pasta, rice, etc.

1 bar of soap

1 package of dry beans  
1 package of cereal or grits  
1 box of crackers  
1 jar of peanut butter  
1 jar of jelly or jam

### Mission News!!!

We are still accepting estimates for our Dorm renovation & repairs. As mentioned last month we are not able to perform these task ourselves. Normally we would have the man power, but due to the extent of these repairs we can not take in new residence and are currently at capacity of this time assisting others with their recovery & needs. Prepare for sticker shock, it has been 35 years since the last time we received estimates from outside the mission, and we were not prepared for what follows.

- ❖ The repairs to the floors -- \$14,899.99
- ❖ Central A/C installation in the dorm -- \$18,402.92
- ❖ Widow Replacement -- \$40,000

This is just the beginning of our greatest needs. It is at this point that we ask you to join us in prayer, that God would either meet this need that we may move forward or that he would open the doors for a relocation site that would allow us to meet the needs of those we serve.

### Mission Updates

For the first time ever, each of our residents are graduates. They are working diligently to provide a better future for themselves. In order that we may best address the issues with the dorm we relocated the graduates over to the old Woman's Mission location. Doing this has stretched the staff thin and increased our transportation expenses. We thank you for your support for without it we couldn't sustain them till they can stand on their own.
