~ Giving thanks for God's faithfulness during 33 years of ministry ~*

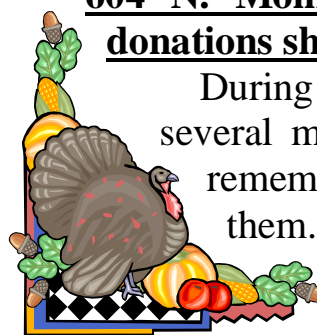
Dear Supporters & Friends,
