Dear Supporters and Friends,

We thank you so much for your continuing support of the Mission. As this hot summer starts to wind down, we want to bring you up to date. We still have not had one COVID case. Between all our locations, and all the public we serve we should have been a hotspot. We think The Lord has protected us, so that we could stay open. Be mindful that this is the last month that all your donations will be doubled. We thank you for all your gifts. (The most important service we provide is often overlooked. We show each one who comes to us how much God loves them. As we share God's plan of salvation, we let them know how trusting in The Lord can change their lives.)

Needs

At the present time, the Mission is near capacity. **This is our most difficult time of the year. Our funds are lower than this time last year, and our need is even greater now!** We run 5 vehicles full-time; fuel is averaging over \$350.00 per week. Last month's utilities for our 14 locations totaled \$5,645.00 due to higher rates and we are still feeding over 7,000 meals per month. Also, our non-perishable food items are in low supply.

Many of you have given extra to help with our needs, and we thank you for your help. The Lord has blessed us through these many years. He has always supplied our needs through many caring people. We hope and pray you will be able to help us to meet these needs. Lastly, we publish many free books. These books can be found on our website @ albanyrescuemission.org

Groceries

Lately, we've had 2 - 3 families a day requesting emergency food bags (a big increase), so the food you shared with us will be distributed quickly! The need continues, and we'd be glad for any part of the list you can give. These are the items we like to include in food bags . . .

- 4 cans of vegetables
- 4 cans of fruit
- 4 cans of meat (tuna, beans, chili, etc.)
- 4 cans of soup
- 1 package of dry beans
- 1 package of cereal or grits
- 1 box of crackers
- 1 package of pasta, rice, etc.
- 1 jar of peanut butter
- 1 jar of jelly or jam
- 1 bar of soap

* We also welcome food to be used at our daily meals! Right now, our cooks would be glad to have some canned meats (like tuna, chicken, or beef stew).
