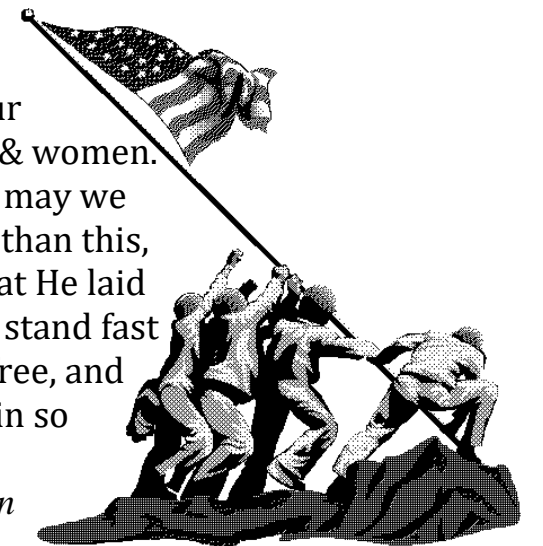


Memorial Day (May 27th 2024)
